2. WATERCOLOUR PAPER 300gsm

THE PAPER YOU USE MUST BE GOOD QUALITY

300gsm, MEDIUM TEXTURE (COLD PRESSED)

ART STORES DO THEIR OWN WATERCOLOUR PADS THAT ARE FINE FOR STUDENT WORKSHOPS.

I RECOMMEND STUDENTS WHO ARE FAIRLY NEW TO WATERCOLOURS TO USE A4 SIZE PADS

MORE EXPERIENCED STUDENTS CAN USE A3 SIZE PADS

I USUALLY PAINT ON 300g ROUGH OR MEDIUM PAPER. I USE A3 PADS OR 1/2 SHEET (350 *500) PAPER.

3. SLOPE BOARD TO PAINT ON

IDEALLY USE A PURPOSE MADE SLOPE BOARD, IF YOU DON'T HAVE A BOARD BUY SOME CORFLUTE AND CUT IT TO FIT YOUR PAPER SIZE.

YOU CAN THEN PLACE THE CORFLUTE ON A KITCHEN TOWEL ROLL, TO CREATE A SLOPE ANGLE OF ABOUT 30 DEGREE.

A LARGISH WATERCOLOUR PALETTE WITH FOUR GOOD SIZE MIXING SECTIONS (OFFICE WORKS DO THESE FOR ABOUT \$5)
